Hello Fellow McCoys, Hatfields and Revenuers,

We're looking forward to seeing everyone on Saturday, September 14! A great time of year in Virginia's Allegheny mountains, so the weather should be perfect.

Thanks for hanging with us as we've worked out reunion details. Here they are:

- The reunion will be held at camp (515 East Morris Hill Rd., Covington, VA; <https://bit.ly/2VYQhuO>) from 10 am to 5 pm.
- The fee is \$50 per person for attendees 14 years old and up and \$20 for 11 to 13 year olds; kids 10 and under are free.
- This covers a catered lunch, event liability & cancellation insurance, pre-event grounds and building cleaning and preparation, and miscellaneous supplies such as drinking water and toilet paper.
- The fee is based on our ability to cover the expected costs for 60 attendees. Surplus fees after covering all reunion costs will be donated to the scholarship fund for Camp Carysbrook (<https://campcarysbrook.com>).

In order to make more time to play and visit at camp, please, **everyone**, do your best to register, pay, and sign a required event waiver **prior** to the reunion. Registration and payments can be submitted online using PayPal or by mail with paper/pencil form & checks, although we hope many of you will use the convenient on-line methods. The registration form includes more detailed information about payment.

Attendees need to arrange their own transportation and lodging. For those staying at the same or nearby locations, please carpool to minimize the impact on camp grounds!
